2	A "Display" application is a terminal, or other graphical user interface, tool or application which only shows market data on a screen or display. Anything else – including, but not limited to, capturing/storing data, performing calculations with data, accessing data in applications such as Excel or Tableau, or sending data elsewhere – is a "Non-Display" application.
3	Web applications are viewed in a browser such as Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Safari or Firefox. Applications which are launched from elsewhere – such as the Start menu on a Windows PC or the Dock on a Mac – are classified as "desktop" applications. A mobile app is an application which can be installed and used on mobile devices such as smartphones and tablets.
